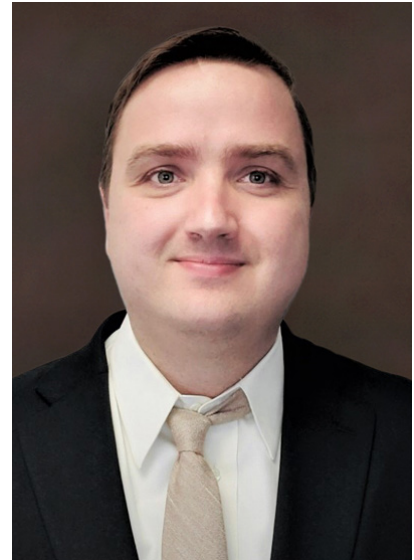


David Migl joins Neel-Schaffer as Water Resources Engineer in Texas
